Harriet Christina Newcomb and Margaret Hodge conducted Shirley, kindergarten and school, 1900-1908. Shirley had operated previously 1865-1885, and continued until merged into Kambala in 1936. Friends and pupils set up a memorial fund, which merged into the Newcomb-Hodge Fellowship in 1950. The purposes of the Fellowship were to keep in memory Miss Newcomb and Miss Hodge and their educational aims and principles, to meet for fellowship and to support or undertake projects to foster the study of the aims and principles of true education.
