

The collection includes photographs of Wunderlich products, manufacturing processes, completed projects, women war workers, and portraits of the Wunderlich brothers and staff, between 1892 and 1971, many of which are identified. A number were for press advertisements, brochures, trade catalogues etc. and for illustrated company histories (see Wunderlich Ltd. Twenty years of Wunderlich Industry 1887-1927, 1927; Sixty years of Wunderlich Industry 188.7-1947, 1947; Seventy years of Wunderlich Industry 1887-1957, 1957 [Q691/W: 691/W Mitchell Library]).
